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Course Objective:

The aim of the course is to develop an understanding of the main concepts of a project and to manage a detailed project in the semester.

Learning Outcomes:

- 1 Have an understanding of the need for project management.
- 2 Analyse the roles of project managers in organizational environment.
- 3 Describe techniques used to manage groups.
- 4 Develop a work breakdown structure.
- 5 Measure of the project performance.
- 6 Apply project plan for resource allocation.
- 7 Implement a project planning and budgeting through a particular software, e.g.,
 MS-Project.

Learning and Teaching Strategies:

1. Lectures

Lectures will cover theoretical basis of project management and class discussions will be carried out over the case studies.

Discussions on case studies will be held in the course, but a report will be prepared in advance for each case study as a homework activity.

Readings

Each week reading texts / articles in the book or from different sources will introduce the basic concepts and techniques of project management. These readings will provide both the theoretical background and technical skills needed to manage any project.

3. Computer Applications

MS Project software will be introduced through various applications in order to manage all phases of the project more effectively.

4. Group assignment

Small groups will be formed according to the number of students and each group will manage a project to solve a problem or issue.

5. Presentations

Students will use presentation techniques and verbal communication skills in project

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presentations.
