IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING COURSE SUCCESS

Upon the decision of the University Senate dated 23.09.2022 and numbered 615/4, changes have been made in the Educational and Examinational Regulation of our Faculty.

Accordingly, in order to be successful in a course that has a final or resit exam, all the following conditions must be met:

- 1. To get at least 35 points from the final or resit exam,
- 2. In case of grading on a Bell Curve, to have a raw success grade of **20** calculated according to the weights of the midterm and final or resit exams,
 - 3. To have a course success grade of at least "**DD**".

Dear Students;

The reason for the above changes in the Educational and Examinational Regulation of our Faculty is to prevent those students who do not take the final exams or take them just to see the questions from passing the course with success

thanks to the application of the BELL CURVE grading by the instructor as happened in the past.

After the changes, since the final exam grade of our students who do not take the final exam will be "0 (zero)"; even if the BELL CURVE grading is applied by the instructor of the course, it will not be possible to pass the course and the students will take the resit exam.

If the average of the grades you receive from the midterm / final / resit exams is 20 and below; your grade will not be included in the BELL CURVE grading system and grade average of the class, and you will be given an FF grade.

If the grade you receive from the Final Exam / Resit Exam is below 35; FF grade will be given.
